When you're ready to create a **draft**, you can use our <u>Artist</u> article template. You can use this template to start the draft in your sandbox.


In order to publish your draft, you'll need to be a <u>confirmed</u> <u>user</u> (which means your account is over 3 days old and you've made at least 10 edits).



Article **Drafts** on Wikipedia


Anyone can **view drafts** on Wikipedia (although they are a bit hidden). This allows users to find and collaborate on each other's articles before they're published.

To find drafts, you'll want to go first to the **search page**, which you can do by clicking the magnifying glass / search icon on any Wikipedia page.




Searching for **Drafts**

Once you're at the search page, click **Advanced** and then check off **Drafts** to search for drafts on a topic you might want to write about or collaborate on.

The Draft namespace

To create a new article, you can click here to get to Wikipedia's draft namespace. Type your article title and click "Create Draft."

eating and editing drafts

rone, including users who are not logged in, may create and edit drafts. Drafts in the namespace have "Draft:" before their normal title, and all e an associated draft talk page. Users who have VisualEditor enabled will be able to use VisualEditor just like on articles. WP:Autoconfirmed ts are required for moving drafts to article mainspace page but you may request a page move at Wikipedia:Requested moves. If there is a unical barrier to the move like the target is create protected, seek an Admin's assistance.



paring drafts

(Optionally) add the template {{Draft article}} at the top of the draft (not the talk page), along with the template's parameters | name | subject= . A list of appropriate subject fields can be found here.


Disable any categories by inserting a colon before the word "Category". Example: change [[Category:Living people]] to [[:Category:Living people]]

Non-free content cannot be included in draft articles per Wikipedia's policy on where non-free media is allowed. Any desired non-free content should be added to the article once it has been moved to the mainspace.

blishing a draft

blishing a draft requires an editor to use the page move function to move it in the Main (article) namespace. This means that anonymous editoregistered editors not autoconfirmed, will need to request publication by inserting into their drafts the relevant template for requesting a page ve. Editors may also optionally submit drafts for review via the articles for creation process.


Edit your draft



Now you can use the **Visual Editor** tools in your toolbar to edit your new draft. You can also copy and paste content from your sandbox!


Don't forget to **CITE**

citations. Review those "basic rules of editing" for a refresher, and keep in mind that providing sources, even just a small number, is valuable in preventing the article's deletion.








and...publish!

Once you're ready to publish (no rush), click **Publish page...** at the top right-hand corner of the page.



Save your changes



You can then add a summary and choose to watch the page, so you'll be aware of any edits that happen. Finally, click **Publish page** in this window.
