Rear seat with folding back. 2 metal grips on each side. Metal rails around rear section. Divided windshield, 2 wipers. Spare on rear. Tires 6.00 - 16. Painted in yellow on each side: No. 1 Jeep. Front bumper. Headlights. Parking lights. 4 cylinder, bore 3.185", stroke 3.75". Piston displacement 119.5 cu. in. H. P. 45 at 3600 r.p.m. Compression ratio 5.8 to 1. Torque maximum pounds feet 84 to 2000 r.p.m. Road weight 2100 pounds. Fuel tank capacity 10.3 gallons. Cooling system 10 quarts. Transmission 1 pint. Transfer case 3 pints. Wheel-base 80". Tread 47.5". Engine G. P. No. 1.
