

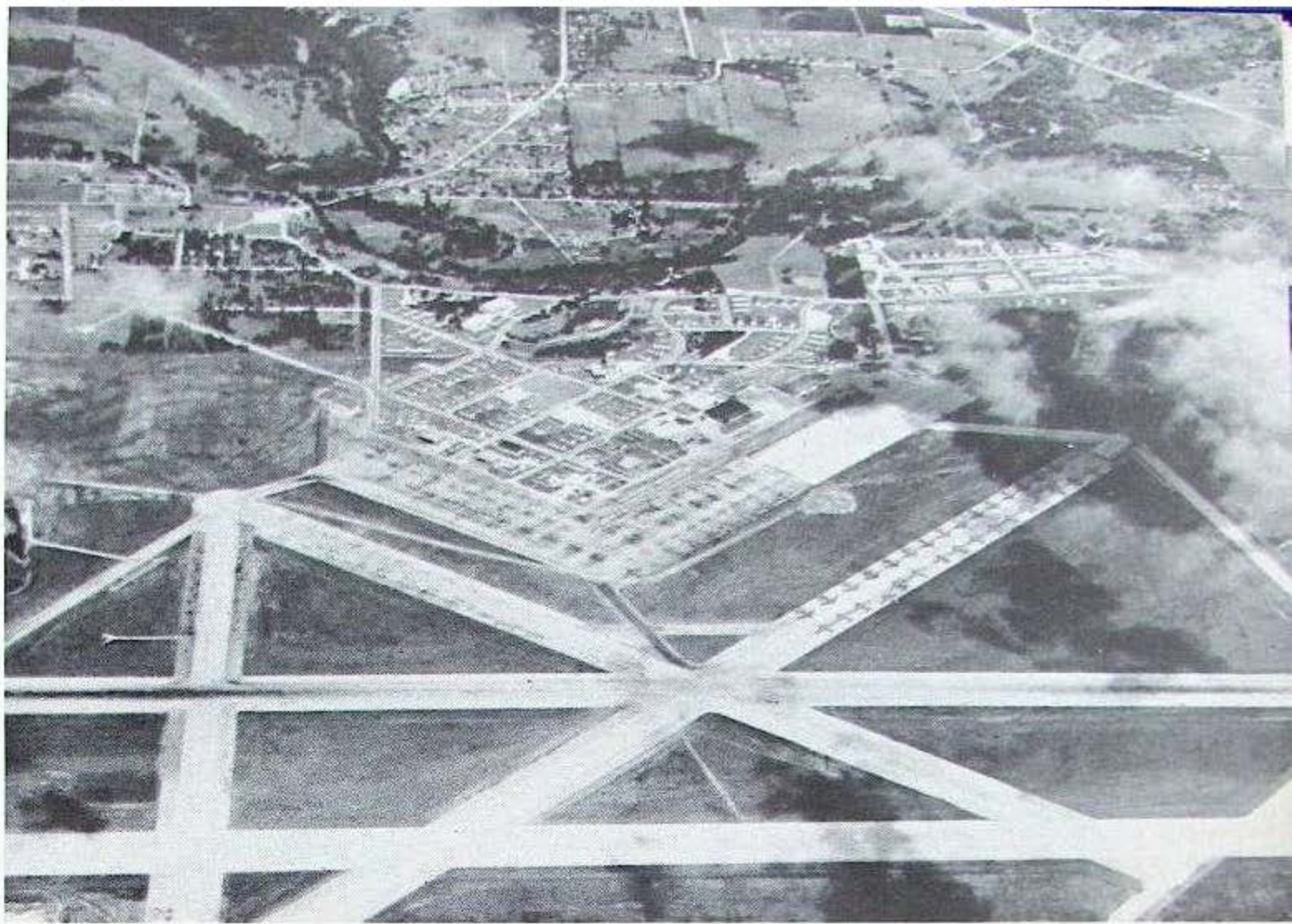

HIGHLIGHTS IN CAREER OF BRIGADIER GENERAL ROGER M. RAMEY

Graduated from West Point Military Academy in 1928 and from advanced flying school in 1929.

Served in various capacities with pursuit units at Selfridge, Randolph and Wheeler fields until 1940 when he became commanding officer of a bombardment squadron at Hickam Field.

At time of Jap attack on Pearl Harbor, was operations officer for 18th Bomb Wing at Hickam and won special commendation for attempts to save planes while enemy planes strafed and bombed hangars, airplanes, and personnel on field.

In the hectic months following sneak attack, General Ramey was in thick of desperate battle to stem Japanese tide, first as deputy chief of staff of Seventh Air Force, then as commanding officer of 43rd Bombardment Group and finally as commanding officer of Fifth Bomber Command.

Directed bombing attacks in support of operations which turned back Jap thrust at Port Moresby and resulted in their expulsion from Papua; was commanding officer of Fifth Bomber Command which sank 22 Japanese vessels in famous battle of Bismarck Sea; directed extensive bombing operations in New Guinea, the Bismarck Archipelago and other sections of the Southwest Pacific; had charge of planning and directing the bombing and strafing attacks during the campaign which led to the capture of Lae, conducted the operations which crushed the strong Jap base at Wewak and directed bombing of critical targets in areas under land attack by allied forces. Received DSM for these operations.

Awarded DFC for conducting first bombing attack on Wake Island and the DSC for "extraordinary heroism" while participating in an attack on the Jap base at Rabaul, New Britain. As command pilot leading a flight against the Rabaul base, Ramey remained at scene of attack for over two hours, making 20 passes over the target, dropping flares on each run and thus drawing attention of searchlights and diverting much of the heavy volume of ack-ack from other bombers to his own.

In latter part of 1943, returned to States to become commanding general of 38th Flying Training Wing at Kirtland Field, and remained there until he was named chief of staff of 21st Bomber Command of Twentieth Air Force. Helped plan and direct early B-29 operations against the Jap mainland from the Marianas and then went to India in January, 1945, to succeed Major General Curtis E. LeMay as commander of the veteran 58th Bombardment Wing.

In April of 1945, General Ramey took the 58th Bombardment Wing to the Marianas where he operated in raids against Japan until the end of the war. Following the cessation of hostilities was put in charge of Operations Sunset, which flew thousands of soldiers home from islands of the Pacific in combat planes.

When plans were formulated for the explosion of two atom bombs at Bikini, General Ramey was placed in charge of Task Force 1.5, the Army Air Forces portion of the combined Army-Navy operations. As commander of that Task Force, he was in charge of all the aerial activity at Bikini. It was a plane from his organization, the old 58th Wing, that dropped atomic bomb No. 4 on the ships in Bikini bay.

When the War Department decided to reactivate the 8th Air Force, famous for knocking the Luftwaffe out of the European skies, the 58th Wing, under General Ramey, was incorporated with remnants of the famous 8th. The marriage of the two famous organizations was on 1 November 1946 at Fort Worth Army Air Field where headquarters was established. For a brief period of weeks, General Ramey was Chief of Staff under Major General Clements McMullen, but in January of 1947 he assumed full command.

General Ramey is one of four brothers in the service. He has almost 7,000 hours of flying time to his credit and participated in 30 bombing missions during the war. He was born in Denton, Texas, where his parents still reside. He attended North Texas State Teachers College before going to West Point. General Ramey is one of the acknowledged authorities on very heavy bombardment in the Army Air Forces and is the only man in the world who commands an Air Force equipped to drop atomic bombs.

The 8th Air Force is comprised of 3 B-29 groups whose mission is the long range defense of America with the latest modern weapons including the atomic bomb. The Air Force is equipped to move and prepared to bomb any place in the world on 10 days notice.

★ History Of Fort Worth Army Air Field

The history of the FWAAFld begins in the spring of 1940 when the Chamber of Commerce and other civic groups started a movement to attract proposed new manufacturing installations to and near the city. American industrial concerns were then in the midst of their defense expansion program and in compliance with the request of President Roosevelt were seeking new sites for new plants inland from the 200 mile wide "Safety Zone" around the coasts and borders of the country.

In May 1940, the Chamber of Commerce communicated with the various aircraft companies regarding available sites in the Fort Worth area. About the same time Major R. H. Fleet, President of the Consolidated Aircraft Corporation of San Diego, Cal., advised Amon G. Carter, Fort Worth publisher and civic leader, that his company was interested in inland sites for new manufacturing installations. In the same month, Brig. Gen., now Maj. Gen. Jacob E. Fickie, arrived in Fort Worth to inspect possible sites for an Army Air Force training base.

The possibility of obtaining an air base as well as an aircraft manufacturing plant spurred the Chamber of Commerce to conduct a survey of sites that would meet commercial and military requirements and opened negotiations with various property owners in anticipation of the acquisition of land. For convenience in designating the various prospective sites the Chamber of Commerce gave the future field its first name—Lake Worth Industrial Airport.

Six months later the WD authorized Major Fleet to select the location for a plant to be constructed by the WD and operated by Consolidated for the building of B-24 bombers on a cost plus basis. The present Fort Worth site was selected on 3 Jan., 1941 after the Chamber of Commerce offered to deed the government 1,450 acres of land for the plant site and landing field—with the city agreeing to clear the land, and build all necessary roads to the proposed site.

Three days later Air Force officials arrived to inspect and pass final judgment on the selection of the land. By March 25 the Austin Company of Cleveland had contracted to build the \$20,000,000 plant, and field offices of the US Engineers were being constructed.

However, the plans for the plant which would ordinarily have taken two years to construct were too slow. President Roosevelt had just called for 50,000 planes a year. Britain needed long range bombers to strike back at the Nazis. The plant to be constructed at Fort Worth was urgently needed to help build up America's defenses and fulfill Lend Lease commitments.

The great speed which was necessary for the development of this ambitious program was attained by the Army Engineers. Practically overnight, the plans which called for two years construction time were slashed to months. Just three and one-half months to the day, the ground was broken for the plant, and three days later on 21 April construction on the plant itself was started.

The L. J. Miles Construction Company of Fort Worth was awarded the contract for the landing area and a few days later the "Tarrant Field Airfield" began to take shape. Early in August the employment rose to more than 2,000 and Fort Worth began to experience its first war-time housing shortage, which was later to become the most serious community dilemma of the war boom.

Meanwhile, the Army Air Force had been casting covetous eyes on the big new airfield which was so admirably adapted to the operation of heavy bombers. In conversation with City and Chamber of Commerce officials, Major General Gerald C. Brant indicated that he would like to see an Air Base established on the new field; a plan which more than pleased the city of Fort Worth.

Negotiations between the Chamber of Commerce and the Army Air Forces were in progress when the Japanese sneak attack on Pearl Harbor forced a speedy decision—Fort Worth was to have its Air Base!

Early in January, 1942, the AAF finally concluded that the best site for a heavy bombardment school was across the field east of the Consolidated Vultee Aircraft Corporation (Government Owned Aircraft Plant No. 4). It was necessary to purchase additional land on which to construct the airbase. The purchase of this land and the plant for construction were carried out simultaneously.

The construction of Tarrant Field was authorized 7 Feb., 1942. And, amazingly enough even for a nation noted for its speed of construction during wartime, Tarrant Field was activated 21 Aug., 1942! There were 107 types of structures built at Tarrant Field, a total of approximately 211 buildings.

Housing facilities were originally designed to accommodate 400 Officers and 3482 Enlisted Men. But, the utilities were designed to

accommodate an increase of fifty per cent above the initial authorized strength. After the various contracts had been let, work proceeded at an amazing speed which was maintained throughout the entire project. A peak employment of 3200 men was reached on 30 June 1942—yet by Dec. 31, 1942, no men were at work. The entire cost of the field was \$6,465,336.67.

On June 26, 1942, Col. Bernard S. Thompson was assigned to duty as Army Air Force representative at Government-owned Aircraft plant No. 4 and was also placed in command of Tarrant Field. Tarrant Field at this time was under the jurisdiction of Second Air Force. Activity of Air Force personnel was completely lacking at this time as the construction of the field under the U.S. Engineers was at its height.

On June 29, Col. David W. Goodrich was placed in command of Tarrant Field when the Gulf Coast Army Air Forces Training Command assumed jurisdiction over the base. Colonel Goodrich wrote GOAAFTC requesting the name of the field. The Command stated the name was to be Tarrant Field Airdrome.

The first cadre of men to arrive at the field consisted entirely of 90 men all of whom were Air Corps Unassigned and came from Ellington Field, Texas. About a week later, 350 men arrived from AAF Recruiting Training Center, Atlantic City, N. J. In the middle of October 1942 the field received its first B-24 airplanes. The coming of the planes raised the morale of everyone on the field—civilians and military alike.

With the arrival of Col. James S. Stowell as commanding officer the field began to get underway. After returning from a study of methods of operation at Smyrna, Tenn., the field's CO started the first transition training at Tarrant Field. The first class of student officers arrived on 14 Oct., 1942, and until the end of the year, flying training was conducted under far from ideal circumstances.

There was a very definite shortage of training aircraft and of flying aircraft and of flying instructors. Since this was one of the first B-24 schools to start operating, many new maintenance problems arose, one of the greatest being the shortage of trained mechanics familiar with B-24 maintenance. Flying, however, was placed on a 24-hour per day basis with instructors and students flying day and night in all but the worst weather. To add to the slightly chaotic character of these first days, for a while the field conducted B-26 transition training until Del Rio, Tex., could have its Air Base completed.

Now Tarrant Field was on its way—from the arrival of the first student officers for transition training until the field was made into a combat crew school, all personnel worked and lived the problem of establishing this field as one of the best in its mission in the AAF. Thousands of problems were confronted and solved by the changing personnel as the station fought to reach the degree of operating efficiency which was desired. Throughout this period the various schools were organized and set-up in smooth working fashion.

Added to the enormous task of setting up a new field was the urgent necessity of producing pilots to man the heavies against our nation's enemies. Through hard work and intensive application of every man to his individual job, the pilots were produced. In this period when the field was a transition school thousands of fresh officer graduates of the various training commands passed through the field to their assignments with the far flung Air Forces of our nation's military might.

Tarrant Field took fresh pilots with their gold bars still shiny and sent them on to the operational units as finished B-24 pilots capable of manning the planes and fighting with their crews and squadrons as a unit. This was the base's contribution during this critical period in late 1942—and 1943—pilots, pilots, and more pilots, was the cry from headquarters AAF, and Tarrant Field produced. The record of intensive training, through application of the principles needed to produce the pilots of the "heavies" stands as proof of the energy, devotion to duty, and thoroughness of the men of the field at this time.

In Jan. of 1945, the transformation of Fort Worth Army Air Field, as it was now known, from a B-24 transition school to preliminary very heavy bombardment transition flying training in B-32's symbolized the most important development in the record of this station's activities.

As the new year began, the instruction of three classes indicated that B-24 transition training was still proceeding on a normal basis. At the conclusion of the first two months of 1945 only one class of students remained in training. In retrospect, it can be seen that the original function of this station as a B-24 transition school has been carried out to the maximum. This is emphasized by the fact that more than 4,000 students have completed transition training here. The successful accomplishment of this training mission illustrates the wisdom underlying the choice of this station to begin B-32 transition training.

In many respects, it was a logical choice to place Fort Worth Army Air Field in the enviable role of inaugurating and developing the new phase of the Very Heavy Bombardment Training program. Among the primary reasons for the selection of FWAAF to inaugurate the B-32 program for the Army Air Forces, aside from its splendid record of the past, was the accessibility to the Consolidated-Vultee plant, manufacturers of the B-32.

All the departments and organizations concerned with the B-32 program formulated temporary plans and procedures necessary for the inauguration of this changeover in aircraft training. The Pilots' Technical School prepared preliminary outlines of ground school lectures and courses, while the Training Aids Division of this department worked on the creation of necessary mock-ups and maintenance aids to be used in classroom work.

Recommendations of the Very Heavy Bombardment conference held at Maxwell Field were followed and the base rapidly settled down to accomplish its new job. A B-32 standardization board was formed and assigned the task of checking out initial instructors on this type aircraft to provide a trained nucleus for future transition work.

In the early months, the main difficulty of the new program was maintenance of the new type aircraft. However this difficulty was greatly overcome by the close coordination established between the Director of Supply and Maintenance and the Consolidated-Vultee plant just across the field. Once again the selection of the site of the field was paying dividends.

On 17 April, 1945, the last of the B-24 students was finished and the field was able to devote its full energies to the B-32 program. More and more experienced personnel were coming to this field to train in the B-32 to take their place beside the B-29 in the aerial war against Japan.

However, in the days following the end of the European war, the most important overall development affecting the field was the WD cutback of production of aircraft. This reduction was immediately felt by the producers of the B-32. Since the provisions stated that their production would end with the end of 1945, until that time their production was limited to a total that was well under previously

planned schedules. A cutback in production of such a specialized type of airplane as the B-32 would, of necessity, have its ramifications at an airfield which was concerned with training of crews for this aircraft. Hence, during the early days of June, personnel of this station was instructed to make the necessary arrangements to transform this school from its mission of transition to that of a combat crew school.

The many and intricate problems which had to be solved prevented the establishment of this type of training during June of 1945, but plans were completed by the end of the month for the inauguration of this new program as soon as it could possibly be put into operation.

Among the difficulties which presented themselves were the lack of housing and building facilities and the absence of gunnery and bombing sites.

B-32's fully equipped for combat crews, were delivered by the Consolidated factory in record-breaking time and numbers to this station, with the result that 63 Dominators were delivered to the field by the end of June. During July, combat crew training at this field was started—and pressing rapidly, was in full swing when the end of the Japanese war brought an abrupt end to the necessity for B-32 crews.

During the period immediately following the end of the greatest war the world has ever known, in Fort Worth Army Air Field as in every village and hamlet, city and town, nation both great and small, a period of glad rejoicing at the end of hostilities and a period of uncertainty began. All policies and activities of the field began to undergo a change to a peace-time Air Force—B-32's training and transition was replaced by a Refresher and Continuation Flying Program.

At this time the field began to first feel the decrease in flying time. A twenty hour month maximum was imposed by the department of Operations and Training. Discharge began to take over and all the talk was of points and changes—wings began to show up in offices of officers and EM as the flying personnel began to replace the ground personnel at this time. There was considerable reduction of maintenance with the reduction of flying time and the decrease of training.

Morale was high—officers and men were looking forward eagerly to their return to civilian life or to the resumption of their careers in the peace-time army. The fighting was over—the furlough policy was liberalized so that 30 per cent of Squadron Strength was authorized to be absent at one time.

During the fall of last year, the main topic of conversation was, as now, demobilization of the war time army, the establishment of a peace time force. Many hundreds of men were discharged during these months but due to the closing of various fields in the AAF the number of men on FWAAF actually increased with the coming to this station of hundreds of officers and men of Combat Crew Schools throughout the country.

In November the Training Command turned command of this field over to the Second Air Force with headquarters in Colorado Springs, Colo. The 17th BOTW (VH) came to this station from Sioux City Army Air Base, Sioux City, Iowa.

The field as we came into the first peace time year since 1942 is in a state of change. From Col. B. S. Thompson and Tarrant Airdrome to Col. T. W. Imlay, the present Commanding Officer, and Fort Worth Army Air Field, we have come a long way—and yet, a lot lies ahead.

With the announcement that we are to take our places as permanent station in the peace time Air Force there came into being a number of problems. This is a new Army—a new Air Forces—a new civilization—the new Atomic age.

Whatever our role in this changing world we now live in we may be sure of one thing. Whatever we of Fort Worth Army Air Field are called to do, whatever our "mission," great or small, important or unimportant—then to the best of our ability, under the able command of Col. T. W. Imlay, we will take our part. We will strive to build an Air Force of which our nation may be proud, a station of which Fort Worth may be proud, and a base, which we, in the army who call it home may be proud.

Fort Worth Army Air Field—in your infancy you produced for the hurried war days—now in your infancy as a peace time installation we will see that through our coordinated efforts you retain the same prestige and respect in our peace time army that you did in war time army. Fort Worth Army Air Field—WE SALUTE YOU!!

From May 1946 to May 1947 Fort Worth Army Air Field has undergone several changes, both physical and administrative. In May 1946 this station was under the jurisdiction of the Fifteenth Air Force, and was composed of the following units: 233rd Army Air Force Base Unit, 448th Bombardment Group, and 376th Air Service Group. Colonel Narcisse L. Cote was the Station Commander at that time.

On 4 August 1946 the 448th Bombardment Group was inactivated and the 92nd Bombardment Group was activated at this station with Colonel John G. Eriksen as Group Commander. The 92nd Bombardment Group absorbed the personnel of the old 448th at time of activation. The organizations of the 92nd Bomb Group were redesignated at the time of activation: 712th Bomb Squadron became the 325th, 713th became the 326th, and 714th was redesignated as the 327th. Organization came the 376th Air Service Group, as well as the Group itself, retained the original designations. On 23 September Colonel John G. Eriksen was assigned Station Commander in addition to being Group Commander.

The 92nd Bombardment Group and 376th Air Service Group were transferred to Salina, Kansas, less personnel and equipment, on 22 October 1946. Personnel were then assigned to the newly-activated 7th Bombardment Group, composed of the 9th, 426th, and 492nd Bomb Squadrons, 25th Base Service Squadron, 35th Air Engineering Squadron, and 578th Air Material Squadron. The 7th Bombardment Group had been previously activated on the station 1 October, though no personnel were assigned until the time of the inactivation of the 92nd.

On November 1 1946 the Eighth Air Force set up Headquarters at this station, and on 17 November assumed command jurisdiction of this station as well as Roswell Army Air Field, Davis-Monthan Field, Tucson, Arizona, and their satellite stations, previously under command of the Fifteenth Air Force.

Colonel Hewitt T. Wheelock was assigned as Group and Station Commander on 16 December, at which time Colonel Eriksen was transferred to Salina, Kansas.

The present mission of the Station is to man, train and equip the Seventh Bombardment Group, and to maintain a combat-effectiveness readiness status of that Group. The Station is organized under the Integrated Station System, and the Group and Station are coordinating in the use of available facilities. Key Personnel of the Group and Station occupy identical positions, a principle factor of the Integrated Station System, set up to effect efficiency and avoid duplication of effort.

The Station and Group are vital links of this Nation's defense, and are key units of the Strategic Air Command and the Eighth Air Force.

BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH ON COLONEL HEWITT T. WHELESS



HEWITT T. WHELESS
Colonel

Colonel Hewitt T. Wheless—a native of Texas, was born the 31st of October, 1913. He is married and is the father of one child.

Colonel Wheless attended the University of Texas and graduated in 1936 with a degree in Civil Engineering. Between the years of 1928 and 1932, he attended the Reserve Officers Training Corps at the Gulf Coast Military Academy to become commissioned a 2nd Lieutenant in the Infantry Reserve. Realizing the great future in the Air Corps, Colonel Wheless enrolled in the Primary and Basic Flying School, Randolph Field, Texas; then to Kelly Field for Advanced Flying Training in May, 1939.

He was then assigned to the 38th Recon. Sqdn., at March Field, California. Here, he received experience in Army Administration while performing the duties as Assistant Operations Officer and as pilot of a B-18.

He left the states in October 1941 with the 19th Bomb Group for an overseas assignment in the Philippines, Dutch East Indies and East Australia. He flew 70 combat missions totaling about 100 combat hours, after which he returned to the United States as a part of the Public Relations Office, Washington, D. C. In Washington he was assigned to duty touring the states visiting war plants as a representative of the War Department. In July 1942, Colonel Wheless returned to the 24th Bomb Group, Geiger Field, Washington, as group Operations Officer. In December 1942, Colonel, then Captain Wheless, was assigned as Deputy Commander of the 88th Bomb Group in Walla Walla, Wash. He directed the activities of a tactical inspection team.

Colonel Wheless joined the 314th Bombardment Wing, Very Heavy Bombardment, and assumed the duties of Deputy Chief of Staff for Operations and Intelligence directing the A-2 and A-3 Sections in June 1944.

The Wing arrived in Guam on the 25th of January 1945, and there Colonel Wheless flew seven more combat missions, totaling 105 combat hours. He became the Chief of Operations for the Wing on September 16, 1945.

While overseas he was mentioned by President Roosevelt in a Fireside Chat for missions performed. Colonel Wheless returned to the United States in October 1945 for processing and reassignment at Fort Worth, Texas. On January 11, 1946, Colonel Wheless was assigned to the 58th Bomb Wing as Chief of Operations and Training.

He wears the Distinguished Service Cross, the Legion of Merit, the Distinguished Flying Cross with one oak leaf cluster and a Presidential Unit Citation.

Colonel Wheless' favorite sports are golf and bowling.

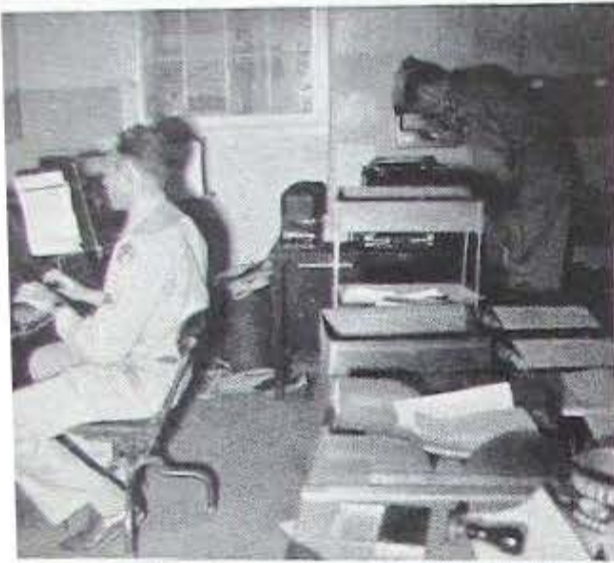

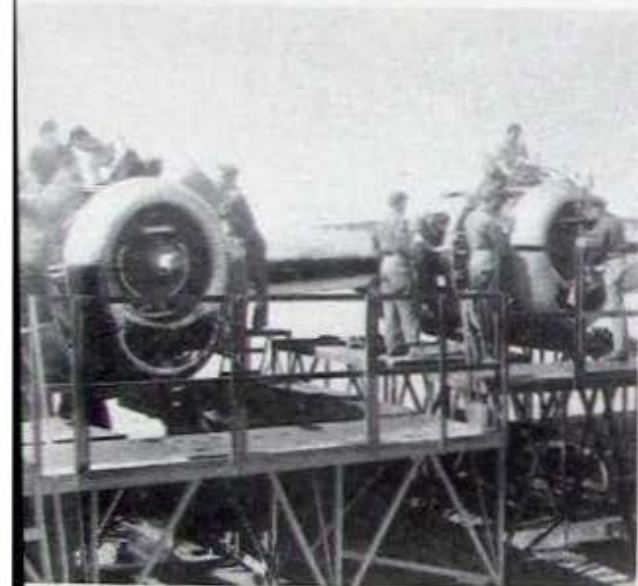




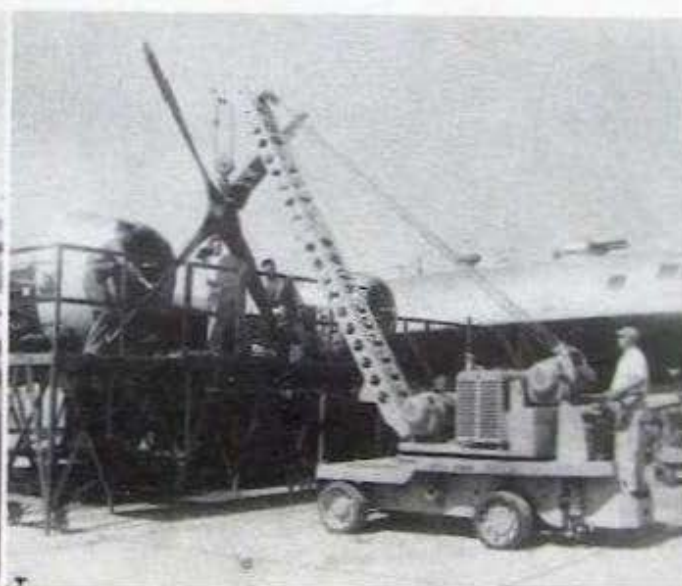

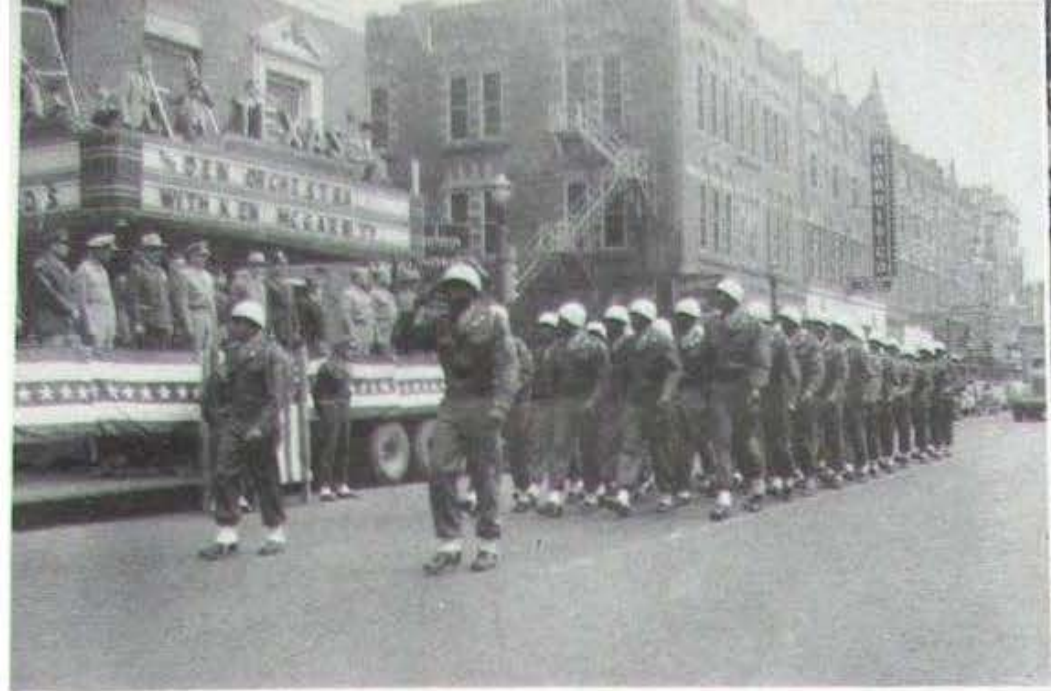
