1. Sometime in December 1946, saboteurs of the UPA (Ukrainian Resistance Army) blew up the power station in Lvov. The city now receives its current from the power station in Tarnopol. The MVD has instituted severe terrorism in Lvov and vicinity.
2. Two days previously, in the Kiev region, on the river Ros (sic), the Korsun-Shevchenkovski power station was blown up. The action was carried out by members of the UPA guerillas. This was a hydro-electric station and the flood following the explosion caused the inundation of the whole region. Casualties among the population were very heavy.
