# **Background and Context: 07-08**

The 07-08 budget was the first in the history of the Wikimedia Foundation.

It was a rough exercise. Very little historical information existed, and much of what did exist was inaccurate.

And, because there was no fundraising staff and insufficient business development capacity, we had no revenue targets.



# **Background and Context: 07-08**

The 07-08 budget posited a total spend of USD 4.6m, up from actuals of 2.1m in 06-07. This represented significant planned increases in technology spending, as well as the filling of key vacancies (e.g., ED, Counsel, CFOO, etc.).

We now project we will spend 2.9m in 07-08.

Despite that, the 07-08 budget turned out to be surprisingly accurate. Overall, we underspent by 1.7m, and tech department underspending equalled 1.7m. Once technical underspending is factored out, the total actuals will be within 1% of budget.



### **Background and Context: 08-09**

The 08-09 plan was constructed as follows:

For the first time in the Foundation's history, we set revenue targets;

In planning spending, we started with 07-08 historical information;

Adjustments were made in consultation with staff and stakeholders (e.g., anticipated growth, anticipated cost increases, adjustment for underspending in prior years);

New spending was approved in key areas, consistent with our strategic goals.



#### 2008-09 Goals

- 1) Achieve organizational maturity
- 2) Achieve financial sustainability
- 3) Encourage and broaden participation
- 4) Increase quality and perception of quality
- 5) Increase distribution beyond the wikis



# **Strategic Spending Priorities**

- 1) Invest in revenue generating staff; (speaks to organizational maturity and financial sustainability)
- 2) Invest in software developers to improve management of volunteer code contributions and to execute strategic priorities (e.g., database dump production, usability initiatives); (speaks to participation, quality, and dissemination goals)
- 3) Invest in key program (mission) staff: Public Outreach, Chief Program Officer and Head of Partnerships. (speaks to participation, quality, and dissemination goals)

# **Variance Explanation**

The 07-08 budget was deliberately conservative to avoid surprises in a transitional year: it's better to be underspent than overspent.

The bulk of underspending was in the technical budget: if you factor out technical underspending, the expected actual spending is within 0.1% of budget.

Technology (-\$1,673): Spending deferred due to general caution, pending sponsorship deals, and delays in hiring

Legal (\$144): Overspending due to unanticipated organizational needs (e.g., charitable registration across all states, trademark status research, employment and immigration support)

Programs (-\$104): Underspending due to deferred hiring

Board (-\$59): Two face-to-face meetings in 07-08 rather than three





#### Resolution

RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees hereby approves management's proposed 2008-2009 annual plan of \$5.97 million of annual expenses, \$7.33 million of annual operating revenues, and an annual operating reserve of \$1.36 million. If during the year management anticipates the annual reserve will differ materially from the planned annual reserve, the Board directs management to consult the Board Treasurer promptly.
